

## Seaside from the Past

- Key Stage 1 (adaptable for KS2)
- Curriculum themes: History, Science, Geography
- Session length: 1.5 to 2 hours
- Session times: 10am – 11.45am or 12.30pm – 2.15pm

What did Bridlington look like 100 years ago? What were old-fashioned swimming costumes like? Find out in tis hands-on workshop exploring continuity and change.

We'll discover how to conserve our heritage with care and sensitivity, investigate habitats and food chains, and find out what we can discover by taking a closer look at the natural history of the seaside.

Have a go at writing scripts, being a Punch and Judy puppeteer, and examining and identifying shells and fossils found on the East Coast.

We begin the workshop with a discussion about the differences between seaside holidays now and the past using images, artefacts and costumes (Victorian costume can be worn for the duration of the workshop!)

We then split into two groups for 30 minute activities:

- Punch and Judy puppeteering and holiday photos with props
- Investigating and handling natural history specimens including sharks jaws, puffer fish, sea birds, fossils and shells
