story, you'll see.

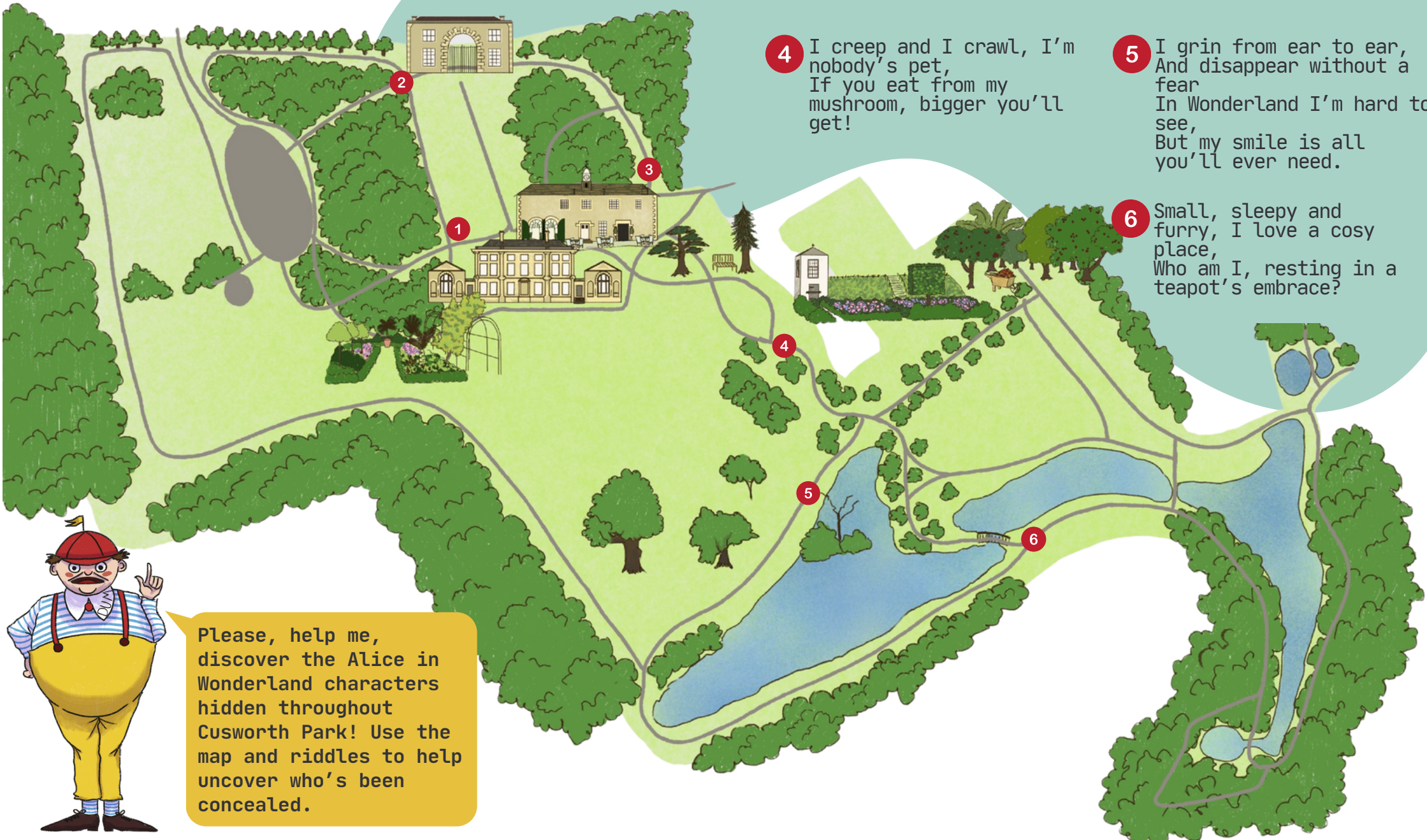
2 In a land of curious
